Experts from reputed academic and research organizations like IIMA, ISRO, PRL and BISAG give their suggestions and feedback for curriculum updates which makes our curricula focused as per industrial requirements Since 1997, 4 students from the department carry out their semester long internship at IIT Bombay. In addition, students have also been to TRDDC, Pune for their internships.

The combination of up-to-date curriculum and the committed, dedicated and competent faculty members has helped our students excel at the national level for the last many years in the GATE/GRE exam for admission to IITs and other reputed institutes of the world.

14 students cleared GRE with flying colours in 2020. 13 students cleared GRE in 2016, 23 students cleared GRE in 2017 and in 2018, our 36 students cleared GRE. In GRE 2017, Varun Shah, a student of Batch 2018, scored 334/340.
